

Transit directions to UIC

Train:

If you arrive in Chicago by the **Amtrak train**, please walk out of the entrance of Chicago Union Station and take either a cab or the bus to **UIC Forum located on 725 W Roosevelt**. If you decide to take the bus, you will have to take **#7** going towards **Congress Plaza** and get off at **900 W Harrison** and then walk on **Halsted towards Roosevelt**. The easier option would of course be to take a cab. It would probably come to about \$10 (single fare) from the Union Station.

Bus:

If you are arriving by bus at the **Greyhound Bus Stop**, you could take a cab from outside the station or the **#7** bus going towards **Congress Plaza** (the stop is right outside the station).

Plane:

If you arrive by plane, you have different options.

You could either take the Chicago Public Transportation or just take a cab to UIC Forum located on 725 W Roosevelt.

Chicago Transit Authority (Public Transportation):

O'Hare Arrival: Please take the **Blue line train** going towards **Forest Park** and get off at the **UIC-Halsted** stop. Walk out of the station and go south on Halsted towards Roosevelt.

Midway Arrival: Please take the **Orange line train** going towards the **Loop** and get off at **Clark and Lake**. At Clark and Lake, you will have to change to the **Blue Line** train going towards **Forest Park** and get off at the **UIC-Halsted** stop.

Alternatively, you could take the Airport Express from the airports to your hotels. From O'Hare, look for vans and tickets counters at Doors 1-E, 2-D, 3-E and 5-D. From Midway, look for vans and ticket agents at Door LL3. Airport Express costs usually half of that of a cab and there is a van every few minutes. The Airport Express Service serves all downtown hotels and most of the suburban locations.

Cab:

The most comfortable means to get to UIC of course is a cab. There are plenty of taxis waiting outside the airport terminal, Greyhound bus stop and the Chicago Union Station. Just take one and tell the driver to go to UIC Forum, 725 W Roosevelt. . A single fare should be – depending on traffic – around \$40 from the airport, \$10 from the Union Station and the Greyhound Bus Stop.
